THE DAY BEFORE your colonoscopy you will be asked to follow a CLEAR LIQUID DIET. Clear liquids will also keep your body hydrated. Please drink plenty of fluids.

What are clear liquids? A good rule of thumb is <u>anything you can see through</u> when held up to a light. <u>DO NOT</u> drink anything with RED, ORANGE or PURPLE dyes.

BEVERAGES

- 1. Water
- 2. Coffee, tea (no milk or creamers)
- 3. Sports drinks (Gatorade, Powerade)
- 4. Fruit juices (apple juice, no pulp or nectars)
- 5. Soft drinks (7-up, sprite, ginger ale, kool aid, crystal light)

SOUPS

- 1. Chicken broth / consommé
- 2. Beef broth/Bouillon
- 3. Vegetable broth

DESSERTS

- 1. Jell-O (lemon or lime is okay)
- 2. Popsicles (no sherbets, or fruit bars with pulp)
- 3. Hard candies

DO NOT EAT

NO solid food, vegetables, fruits NO bread, cereal, grains, pasta, rice NO milk or dairy products NO meat, chicken or fish NO nuts or tofu

1.DO NOT EAT OR DRINK AFTER MIDNIGHT OTHER THAN THE COLONOSCOPY PREP. THIS INCLUDES WATER AND COFFEE

- 2. <u>IF YOU TAKE BLOOD PRESSURE MEDICATION</u>, PLEASE TAKE IT WITH A SIP OF WATER 4 HOURS PRIOR TO YOUR PROCEDURE.
- 3. MAKE SURE YOU HAVE A RIDE TO AND FROM THE SURGERY CENTER DUE TO THE ANESTHESIA (YOU CANNOT UBER OR LYFT)

GoLytely PREP INSTRUCTIONS

DAY PRIOR TO YOUR EXAM:

- Start on a clear liquid diet for the entire day.
- In the morning mix the GoLytely solution according to the instructions in the kit and refrigerate. It will taste much better.
- At 5:00pm you should have started to drink <u>HALF</u> of one gallon GoLytely as instructed.
- Approximately 1 cup every 10-20 minutes. Slow down if you feel nauseated.
- You can continue clear liquids after that but nothing at all after midnight

DAY OF THE PROCEDURE:

- Drink the second <u>HALF</u> gallon of the preparation starting <u>7 HOURS BEFORE</u> your exam's scheduled time. (eg: if your appointment is at 10am, you should start at 3am. You MUST finish the second half within 3 hours so your stomach is empty for your exam.
- After completing the bowel preparation, your stools should be very watery and clear vellow.
 - *** Please contact our Pacific Endo surgical center if your stools are <u>NOT</u> clear yellow or if you are concerned with the result of the preparation. Pacific Endo-Surgical Center phone: (310)326-1666***
- Please arrive 2 hours before your scheduled time to Surgery Center
- Please bring a list of your current medications along with correct dosage to your appointment as well.
- Due to the sedatives given you cannot drive for the remainder of the day.
- You will be sedated for your procedure so please plan to avoid having to make any important decisions for the remainder of the day after your procedure.
- We cannot be responsible for any lost or valuable items. Please leave them at home or with the person bringing you to your appointment.

Remember: If you don't have someone to provide a ride to your exam it could or will be canceled and rescheduled to a later date. No uber, lyft or taxi is allowed to drop or pick you up from your procedure!
